

Certificate 3 Guarantee

The Certificate 3 Guarantee Program supports eligible individuals to complete their first post-school Certificate III qualification. The skills attained help to support students to develop skills to pursue employment, re-enter the workforce or advance in their chosen field of work. The Certificate 3 Guarantee Program is funded under the Queensland Department of Education and Training.

As part of the Certificate 3 Guarantee Program is it a requirement that a co-contribution fee be collected. This fee may be paid by you or on your behalf by an employer or another third party. Students who are eligible for a concession must supply sufficient evidence at enrolment.

Delivery Modes available:

Survey:

The User Choice Program provides a public funding contribution towards the cost of training and assessment for eligible Queensland apprentices and trainees. The User Choice Program is funded under the Queensland Department of Education and Training.

As part of the User Choice Program is it a requirement that a co-contribution fee be collected. Fees under the User Choice program are set at \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency to be calculated at the commencement of the unit of competency. This fee may be paid by you or on your behalf by an employer or another third party. Students who are eligible for a concession must supply sufficient evidence at enrolment.
